MINUTES

FORT BEND COUNTY LEVEE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 19

March 23, 2018

The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Levee Improvement District No. 19 (the "District") met in regular session, open to the public, on March 23, 2018, at the Greater Fort Bend Economic Development Council, One Fluor Daniel Drive, Lakepoint Plaza, Building D, Conference Room, Sugar Land, Texas 77478, outside the boundaries of the District, and the roll was called of the members of the Board:

and all of the above were present except Director Thompson, thus constituting a quorum.

Also present at the meeting were: Kalapi Sheth, Radhika Iyer, and Uma Ramamurthy, District residents; Mike Stone of Mike Stone Associates, Inc.; David Smalling of Robert W. Baird & Co.; Shashi Kumar of the City of Missouri City; Bobby Skinner of Taylor Morrison of Texas, Inc.; Shannon Waugh of Off Cinco; John Schnure of TBG Partners; Trey Reichert of Johnson Development; Jeff Perry, Ross Awtry, and Jimmy Thompson of Levee Management Services, LLC; Kristy Hebert of Tax Tech, Inc.; Chad Hablinski of Costello, Inc. ("Costello"); Pamela Lightbody of AVANTA Services; and Nancy Carter, Keely Campbell, and Tara Miles of The Muller Law Group, PLLC ("MLG").

PUBLIC COMMENTS

There were no public comments.

MINUTES

The Board considered approving the minutes of its February 23, 2018, regular meeting and March 9, 2018, special meeting. Following review and discussion, Director Arndt moved to approve the minutes as submitted. Director Green seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

TAX ASSESSOR/COLLECTOR'S REPORT

Ms. Hebert presented the tax assessor/collector's report, a copy of which is attached. She reviewed the checks presented for payment from the tax account and said 94.91% of the District's 2017 taxes had been collected as of February 28, 2018. Ms. Hebert reported that she received a request from a resident at 3803 Hunters Gate Court to waive the penalty and interest on his tax account due to non-receipt of his tax bill. Ms. Hebert stated that the property tax code does not allow for such waiver. After review and discussion, Director Arndt moved to approve the tax assessor/collector's report, payment of the bills listed in the report, and to deny the request for waiver of penalty and interest. Director Green seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

RESOLUTION CONCERNING EXEMPTIONS FROM TAXATION

The Board considered adopting a Resolution Concerning Exemptions from Taxation (the "Tax Resolution"). After review and discussion, Director Green moved to adopt the Tax Resolution, reflecting a \$10,000 tax exemption for homeowners over 65 years of age and disabled, and direct that the Tax Resolution be filed appropriately and retained in the District's official records. Director Arndt seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

FINANCIAL AND BOOKKEEPING MATTERS

Ms. Lightbody presented the bookkeeper's report, including the list of bills for payment, a copy of which is attached, and reviewed Certificate of Deposit investment changes. Following review and discussion, Director Arndt moved to approve the bookkeeper's report and payment of the bills listed in the report. Director Green seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Discussion ensued regarding electricity bills, and Mr. Hablinski stated that the District's new electricity contract with the General Land Office begins next month.

HURRICANE HARVEY MATTERS

THIRD-PARTY ENGINEERING REVIEW

Ms. Carter distributed the most recent status report from Aptim Environmental & Infrastructure, Inc. ("Aptim"), a copy of which is attached. Mr. Stone reported that Aptim conducted an inspection of the District's facilities and that they anticipate delivering the Phase 1 report by next month. Following discussion, the Board concurred to hold a special meeting to review the Aptim report on Friday, April 20, 2018.

REVIEW OF RECOMMENDED PROJECTS

Ms. Carter distributed and reviewed an After Action Report - Regional Project Task List, a copy of which is attached, and reviewed the District's proposed cost share percentages for the pump stations and interconnects. Mr. Hablinski discussed the projects and the necessity of the Snake Slough Pump Station due to the new development by Taylor Morrison. Mr. Hablinski also noted that he will attend the First Colony Levee Improvement District meeting on April 16, 2018, to discuss their requested cost share of the proposed Lost Creek Pump Station.

Mr. Perry reviewed an updated summary of temporary pump options, a copy of which is attached. Discussion ensued regarding paying for the pumps from the general operating fund. Ms. Carter stated that she communicated with Newmark Homes regarding their pending reimbursement for The Grove Detention and that Newmark understood that the Board had discretion to include the project in a future bond issue instead of using the District's operation and maintenance tax revenues for reimbursement. Mr. Smalling stated that adding The Grove Detention project to the next bond issue would not require an increase to the District's current property tax rate. The Board discussed the purchase of additional temporary trailer mounted pumps prior to the start of the hurricane season on June 1, 2018. The Board concurred that an emergency condition existed, requiring immediate action to

purchase pumps to ensure delivery prior to June 1, 2018. Following review and discussion, Director Green moved to authorize Director Thompson to execute a purchase contract not to exceed \$1,685,250, for the purchase of temporary pumps to provide an additional 80,000 gallons per minute of pumping capacity. Director Arndt seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. Ms. Carter stated that she would discuss the terms for sharing the costs of the purchase and maintenance of the pumps with Fort Bend County Levee Improvement District No. 15 ("LID 15") at their next Board meeting.

RECOVERY-RELATED ITEMS

Mr. Perry distributed photographs of message board options, copies of which are attached. Following discussion regarding permanent versus temporary options, Director Arndt requested pricing for portable trailer mounted and permanent monument signs.

The Board discussed holding its community meeting to update residents on post-Harvey action items on May 19, 2018, at the Riverstone club house pending availability.

Mr. Hablinski reported on the findings of Moving Water, Inc. ("MWI"), regarding the Board's prior inquiry to determine if the capacity of the District's existing pumps could be increased, noting that the options presented by MWI were not economically or practically feasible for the District.

DISTRICT WEBSITE

Director Arndt discussed the District's website and recommended separating the District's website from LID 15's website in order to more clearly communicate with Riverstone residents.

Ms. Waugh presented a proposal from Off Cinco, a copy of which is attached, to establish a separate website, www.fblid19.com, for the District, and keeping www.riverstonelids.com as a launch point to each individual district's website, for a one-time fee of \$600. After review and discussion, Director Arndt moved to approve (i) Off Cinco's proposal to create a separate website for the District in the amount of \$600 and ii) a new Service Agreement with Off Cinco and direct that the Service Agreement be filed appropriately and retained in the District's official records. Director Green seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. The Board requested that the executed minutes be added to the website on a going forward basis. Ms. Miles noted Off Cinco's Form 1295 had been submitted.

CLAIMS FOR FEDERAL REIMBURSEMENT FUNDS AND GRANTS

Mr. Perry stated that Federal Emergency Management Agency is reviewing the submitted documentation for potential reimbursements.

LITIGATION

There was no discussion on this agenda item.

DIRECTORS ELECTION

Ms. Carter reviewed the status of the Directors Election, noting there were no candidates for Precincts 2 and 4, two candidates for Precinct 1, and 1 candidate each for Precincts 3 and 5.

CERTIFICATE DECLARING UNOPPOSED CANDIDATES

The Board considered accepting a Certificate Declaring Unopposed Candidates for the May 5, 2018, Directors Election (the "Certificate"), reflecting the following unopposed candidates:

After review and discussion, Director Green moved to accept the Certificate and direct that the Certificate be filed appropriately and retained in the District's official records. Director Arndt seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

ORDER PARTIALLY CANCELLING ELECTION MEASURE AND DECLARING UNOPPOSED CANDIDATES ELECTED TO OFFICE

The Board considered adopting an Order Partially Cancelling Election Measure and Declaring Unopposed Candidates Elected to Office (the "Order"), (i) cancelling the measure on the election of directors for Precincts 2, 3, 4, and 5 and (ii) declaring unopposed candidates John Arndt and Radhika Iyer elected to office upon their signing of sworn statements, bonds, and oaths of office after the May 5, 2018, election, if the proposition to change from appointed to elected directors passes. After review and discussion, Director Green moved to adopt the Order and direct that the Order be filed appropriately and retained in the District's official records. Director Arndt seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

NOTICE OF PARTIAL CANCELLATION OF ELECTION MEASURE

The Board considered approving a Notice of Partial Cancellation of Election Measure (the "Notice") to be posted on the website and in the District, notifying electors of the cancellation of the measure on the election of directors for Precincts 2, 3, 4, and 5. After review and discussion, Director Green moved to approve the Notice and direct that the Notice be filed appropriately and retained in the District's official records. Director Arndt seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

OPERATOR'S REPORT

Mr. Perry presented the operator's report, a copy of which is attached, and reviewed repairs and maintenance performed since the last Board meeting. Mr. Perry reported that the load bank test on the generator will be conducted at the end of the month.

Ms. Carter reported on the paver repairs to LJ Parkway at the levee crossing, stating that Fort Bend County Levee Improvement District No. 2 is proceeding with the repairs.

MOWING REPORT

No mowing report was presented. Mr. Koehl stated that Yellowstone completed its first mowing cycle of the year and that the spring overseeding is commencing.

FORT BEND COUNTY FLOOD MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATION AND PERIMETER LEVEE MATTERS

Ms. Carter reported on several upcoming regional meetings, including: i) the perimeter levee meeting on April 10, 2018, ii) the Texas Water Development Board workshop regarding state funding options on April 10, 2018, and iii) the Fort Bend County flood fighting tabletop exercise on April 6, 2018.

STORMWATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

There was no discussion on this agenda item.

ENGINEERING MATTERS

Mr. Hablinski presented and reviewed the engineer's report, a copy of which is attached.

Mr. Hablinski reviewed a report voluntarily prepared by Acclaim Energy Advisors regarding potential efficiencies with the District's power usage and billing. Discussion ensued regarding the advantages and disadvantages of diesel versus natural gas generators for the pump stations.

The Board discussed the previously approved Resolution Authorizing Application to Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("TCEQ") for Use of Operation and Maintenance Tax Revenues (the "TCEQ Resolution"), for reimbursement to Newmark Homes for construction of The Grove Detention Pond. Pursuant to discussions earlier in the meeting regarding utilizing said operation and maintenance tax revenues to fund the temporary pumps instead of reimbursing Newmark, Director Green moved to rescind the TCEQ Resolution and void the check for \$100 to the TCEQ. Director Arndt seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

PARK AND RECREATIONAL FACILITY MATTERS

Mr. Schnure presented the landscape architect's report, a copy of which is attached.

Mr. Schnure presented and recommended approval of Pay Estimate Nos. 8 and 9 and Final in the respective amounts of \$13,381.96 and \$1,486.89 to Texas Wall and Landscape for the construction of sitework, landscape, and irrigation to serve LJ Parkway Phase 8, along with Change Order Nos. 6 and 7 in the respective amounts of \$1,200.00 and \$13,668.85. He stated that the project is complete and recommended acceptance of the project. After review and discussion, Director Arndt moved to approve the aforementioned pay estimates and change orders and to accept the project. Director Green seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

DEVELOPER'S REPORT

Ms. Reichert presented a report, a copy of which is attached, on the status of development in Riverstone. Director Arndt reported that residents have requested sidewalks connecting Elkins High School along Oilfield Road.

RESOLUTION CHANGING DISTRICT OFFICES AND ESTABLISHING ADDITIONAL OUT-OF-DISTRICT MEETING PLACES

The Board considered adopting a Resolution Changing District Offices and Establishing Additional Out-of-District Meeting Places (the "Resolution"), reflecting the new addresses of the offices of MLG and Costello as offices of the District and additional places for Board meetings. After review and discussion, Director Green moved to adopt the Resolution and direct that the Resolution be filed appropriately and retained in the District's official records. Director Arndt seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the Board concurred to adjourn the meeting.
